

Booster Club Minutes
Monday, August 3, 2009

The D.A. Booster Club held its August meeting on Mon., Aug. 3 in Jeff's office in the front wing of the school. A large group of interested volunteers was present, including officers, President Vance Collier, Vice President Shirley Westbury, Secretary Julie McAlhany, Treasurer Mark Fralix; as well as Headmaster Karen Neil, Athletic Committee Head and Board Member Candi Creel, Football Director Stanley Gruber, Athletic Director Jeff Aumend, Board Members Scott Garris and Paul Garrett; also Harvey Kizer, Bryan Hutto, Penny Fender, Lynn Fralix, Derrill Austin, Anthony McAlhany, David Berry, Tina Berry.

The **first home football game** is Friday, August 28. The **first home volleyball game** is Tuesday, August 25.

Immediate needs for the various school teams were discussed first. Coach Gruber suggested a new scoreboard for the football field, and a new scoreboard for the softball field was also suggested. Possible sponsors for these signs were brought up, but no decisions were made. Uniforms for the volleyball teams were also discussed.

Super Booster Club information sheets had been prepared and ready to mail (by Penny Fender), and the Booster Club decided to add a sticker to the back of the already sealed envelopes, advertising our **new Dog Pound Parking Pass**. These will be available for \$100, and can be purchased along with a Super Booster Pass. There will be 18 special parking passes available, and they will be sold on a lottery-style basis. If we have over 18 boosters who would like to buy a pass, we will draw for the passes. If we sell less than 18, we will block off the remaining parking slots. These spaces are in the "Dog Pound" section of the field, at the end zone fence on the end of the field nearest the concession stand and parking lot. A sign with the booster's name will be placed at their designated parking spot at the fence.

Shirley Westbury is handling the **advertising signs** around the football field. Bryan Hutto is in charge of the **football concession stand**. Penny Fender will handle the scheduling of the **concession stand workers** (parents), and Jeff Aumend will take care of scheduling teachers to work the **admission gates** at the home football games. The Booster Club is still looking for a parent volunteer to handle the **volleyball concession stand duties**, including stocking and scheduling.

Board member Paul Garrett then presented several improvement projects he has in mind for the school grounds.

The Booster Club adjourned to meet again next month.
